Jamie Duguid won the Lothians men's golf championship with a 4 & 3 victory over Scott McCandless at **Duddingston Golf Course** describe The *Edinburgh Reporter*.

The *Edinburgh News* reported on a meeting at the City Council that decided to postpone a decision (for the



second time) on whether to make cycle lanes around Duddingston permanent after there was confusion over the quality of proposed permanent upgrades. The infrastructure along London Road, Willowbrae Road and Milton Road West have been in place since the pandemic under temporary legislation that will fall away in October. If a decision to make them

permanent is not made by then, they will have to be removed.

An Edinburgh resident was astonished to find a giant lion's mane jellyfish, "the size of a dog," washed up on



Portobello beach. Lion's mane jellyfish, native to Scottish waters and among the world's largest, can deliver painful stings even when dead. The NHS advises seawater rinsing, warm water soaking, and painkillers for treatment, report Edinburgh Live.



Dear Ben,

I always enjoy reading Duddingston magazine, and the latest edition was no exception—thank you for your continued efforts in bringing local stories to life. One article in the news section particularly caught my eye: the call to reopen Duddingston Low Road. I felt it was important to highlight that there are also strong calls for the road to remain closed.

Holyrood Park is a designated Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI), and Duddingston Loch is both an SSSI and a Scottish Wildlife Trust reserve. The park is incredibly biodiverse, home to hundreds of species of birds, toads, butterflies, mammals, plants, trees, ferns, lichens, fungi, and mosses. This delicate environment is adversely affected by vehicle traffic through the parkespecially through increased noise, light, and air pollution.

Many existing user groups, including pedestrians and cyclists, support keeping the road closed to motor traffic. There are numerous alternative routes into the city, and maintaining the current closure helps protect the park's unique natural character and tranquillity.

I would also encourage a



closer look at the claim that the closure has caused significant traffic delays. As a local resident, this has not been my experience, and it may be worth fact-checking for balance.

It would be wonderful if the magazine could explore the other side of this discussion, including the many environmental and community benefits of keeping the road closed.



Fringe in the East

If you were in the centre of Edinburgh last month, you would have no doubt found it impossible to ignore the various Fringe and Festival events taking place around you. However, although the majority of shows and experiences could be found in the middle of the city, there were also plenty of things on offer more locally in the east.

In Portobello, the Town Hall was one of the spaces used as a venue for the Fringe with its old-fashioned set-up, large stage and theatrestyle balcony, creating a conventional experience for viewers. Despite these distinct features that would suggest performances such as Shakespeare, the events held at the hall were far from shows traditionally shown at such a place in previous decades, very much keeping up with the modern-day Fringe ethos. Types of performances at Portobello Town Hall included dancing, live music, DJ sets, food showcases, plays and children's shows. A busy month for the venue, with a maximum capacity of 800, meant plenty of tickets were sold, ensuring a great experience for all.

Also nearby, the Beach Lane Social Club got in on the action with a Fringe edition of 'The Portobello Comedy Night'. The 3-hour-long



special of the regular event, making its return from a summer break, starred Patrick Monahon to get the laughter flowing.

Closer to Duddingston, something completely different was going on over by Thomson's Tower at Dr Neil's Garden. In the ancient



structure, a much more relaxing experience could be had through the form of art viewing. After a venture through the incredibly scenic garden next to the just as picturesque Duddingston Loch, you could step inside Thomson's Tower and be greeted by art, which included textiles, ceramics, paintings, and tapestries that explore various themes throughout. This exhibition was suitable for all ages, which made seeing different groups, presumably with many different primary interests, all being in the same place at different times, with different takes, viewpoints and preferences of the artwork in front of them, a nice experience built around community spirit.

This is merely just a taste of what was



available and only a slight peep at the true experience. The Fringe is all about communities, and with events being local to residents outside of the centre of Edinburgh, people can come together and celebrate the arts locally. And as a result of the success of this year, it might be possible on an even larger scale in the East in 2026.








