Here is a summary of some of the main articles reported by a range of media outlets and posted on our Facebook Page that relate to our local area including Duddingston, Brunstane, Portobello & Willowbrae.



Duddingston Golf Club

announced its trophy winners, with James Walker claiming the senior golfers' 7-hole/3-club competition on a countback after tying with John Davie at 15 stableford points. Separately, Maureen Allan was named the senior section's "Player of the Year" for becoming the first female to represent the section in a match against another club, say *The Edinburgh Reporter*.

A curious collection of bones was found on Crow Hill near Arthur's Seat.

They were from several species, including cattle, horse, and possibly cat. Specialists plan



to radiocarbon date the post-medieval remains to determine their age and origin, report *New York Post*.

Edinburgh Evening News report that Edinburgh City Council's transport committee has approved the restart of plans for long-delayed **Controlled Parking Zones (CPZs) in five areas including Willowbrae North and Lochend**. The plabs, which



require residents to pay for parking permits, were previously put on hold after public opposition.

The neighbourhood covering **Bingham, Magdalene, The Christians, and Niddrie has been awarded £20Mil** in UK Gov funding over the next decade. The "Pride in Place" programme, which is aimed at improving local areas and required five Capital



neighbourhoods to bid against each other for the cash, report *Edinburgh News*.

The **Portobello U14 youth rugby team**, fundraising for a 2026 international trip to Italy by selling Christmas trees, were devastated after thieves stole 8 of their trees according to *Edinburgh Live*.



The Scottish band, known for their dynamic fusion of English and Gaelic songs with traditional instruments, has been announced as the headliner for the Saturday evening stage at the Porty Festival on May 2, 2026, performing at Portobello Town Hall. The second annual festival's full program is expected to include various community events like markets, runs, and a dog show, say *The Edinburgh Reporter*.



Edinburgh News ran a story about plans have been submitted to the City of Edinburgh Council by the community group **Action Porty to transform the vacant former Portobello Police Station** (originally the Portobello Town House, built in 1878) into a new community hub. This happened after Action Porty acquired almost £500,000 from the Scottish Land fund for the project.

Plan to reopen South-Sub on track, with stops in Duddingston and Portobello.

Much earlier this year, a solution to reopen the South Suburban Railway was put forward by a group of civil engineering students using tram-trains as part of a university project.

Now, the idea looks like it could well come to fruition as a result of high levels of popularity from locals and figures of authority within the city. A group has now also been formed in support of the movement, which displays a high level of public support for the reopening of the line.

The proposal includes a connection being situated at Murrayfield for the Edinburgh Tram Network in the West by using converted trams that have wheels that can operate on both railway tracks and tram lines.

The plan would also include a stop in local areas such as a new station in Portobello and the reopening of Duddingston and Craigmillar Station, which had previously closed in 1962. This would allow a connection for those nearby to travel from stops including Gorgie, Craiglockhart and Morningside.



MEng Civil Engineering students Corey Boyle, Caitlin Cummings, Chang Xun Tan, Natalia Greenan, and Yuen Fong Hoo.

The main positives of this idea are that it would provide a sustainable transport system, whilst also removing congestion from buses.

Caitlin Cummings, one of the students at the heart of mapping out the proposal so far, has graduated from Heriot-Watt since she first started on the project. Despite this, she is still very much supportive of the movement and would love to see something she was involved with have a positive effect on people:

“I feel very grateful, and I am proud to have been a part of what has happened so far because we had absolutely no idea how big this project would get and how far it would go.





"As a lot of the projects we completed at university were theoretical, this being pulled so far, the possibility of it being put into place and putting it in front of the council and MSPs is amazing to see."

The students' brief for their initial university project was to come up with an idea that would have an impact on communities, and Caitlin believes that the proposal really could have a positive effect in real life due to the proposed low cost for users:

"Bringing in tram stations and train stations provides access for low-income and deprived areas to be able to access important services and to have more direct routes to jobs and education."

Before the plan can progress any further, a fully funded feasibility study is required, but a campaign group is available for anyone to join to ensure that the issue is kept in people's minds.






Rightmove.com produce maps of house prices and I count 1 in our area for over £1Mil in the last year (darkest brown circles) and 28 for less than £200k (lightest yellow circles) The remainder were all "mid level".

Each question contains a number and some initials for a common phrase, or an item that has something to do with that number,. The number is your best clue - think about things that start with those initials that involve that number!

EXAMPLE: 16 O. in a P.

Answer: 16 Ounces in a Pound

And remember...this game does not measure your intelligence, your fluency with words, and certainly not your mathematical ability. It will, however, give you some idea of your mental flexibility and creativity.
