

Detectives were called in October after two men broke into a property in **Silverknowes** Midway and demanded car keys to a BMW 1 series.




The occupants were shaken but not injured, according to the **Edinburgh Reporter**

The number 13 bus running through Blackhall between Craigleith Retail Park and Lochend is at risk because of timetable reliability issues. In a Report to the Councils' Transport Committee, operator McGills said if obstructions from parked cars can't be resolved, they may have to reduce the service.





Tram Extension Consultation

Following discussion at the September meeting, a draft of the Community Council's comments had been circulated. Concerns about the £2.9Bil cost were again aired as was the absence of funding. Despite the existing tram line being well used, it is financially non viable and an extension could add to financial burden. Alternative solutions should be investigated for better value e.g. bus rapid transit or lighter weight trams, without a major environmental impact on the Roseburn Path.

Craigleith Tunnel

Options considered including closure & improvements to be implemented by March 2026 to reduce traffic speed, improve sight lines and an better matrix warning for a safer pedestrian route but no solution will be absolutely safe.

Ward Councillor Reports

Strachan Road pedestrian lights crossing

Groathill Road South tunnel - rumble strips to be installed to assess traffic volumes.

Blackhall Primary School area - measures being considered including a pedestrian crossing and improvements to Ravelston Dykes Road / Craigcrook Road junction.

No 13 bus - delays are due to inconsiderate parking.

Blackhall Library - a temporary library at Davidson's Mains Primary School is being installed.

Maidencraig Steps in poor condition and 2 residents had fallen - Blackhall Dip Christmas Tree - the community council agreed to fund the tree and lights again.








Reduce your Stress Burden

Smile about it: It's much harder for stress to exist in a fun, laughter-filled environment, so put yourself in a position to smile when you're under stress. After all, laughter truly is the best natural medicine.

Talk about it: When you're stressed, your mind can be a continual stream of negative, overwhelming, stressed-out thoughts. Don't keep it all to yourself; sometimes the best way to reduce your stress is to vent about it and get a neutral perspective, rather than staying in a bottled-up, stressed-out state.
